1/ Introduction and General Terms

2/ What information will VALLEY OF THE HARE collect about me?

We collect this standard information by using 'cookies'. A cookie is a small file placed on a user's computer by a website. Cookies are widely used to make websites function properly, work more efficiently or to provide information to the owners of the site. Please see further details in section 8.

3/ How will VALLEY OF THE HARE use the information it collects about me?

In order to request information about Valley of the Hare or submit an enquiry, you will be asked to submit personal information about yourself (name, e-mail address etc). We will keep your information within Valley of the Hare except where disclosure is required or permitted by law (for example to government bodies and law enforcement agencies).

5/ How long will VALLEY OF THE HARE keep my information?

6/ Can I find out what personal information VALLEY OF THE HARE holds about me?

7/ Web browser cookies

What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small amount of data, which often includes a unique identifier that is sent to your computer, tablet or mobile phone web browser from a website's computer and is stored on your device's hard drive.
